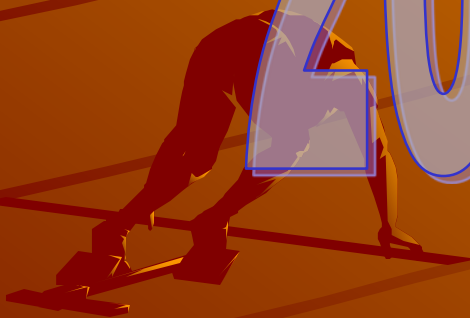
Latinos Making a Difference

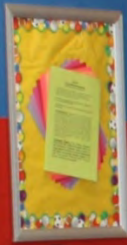

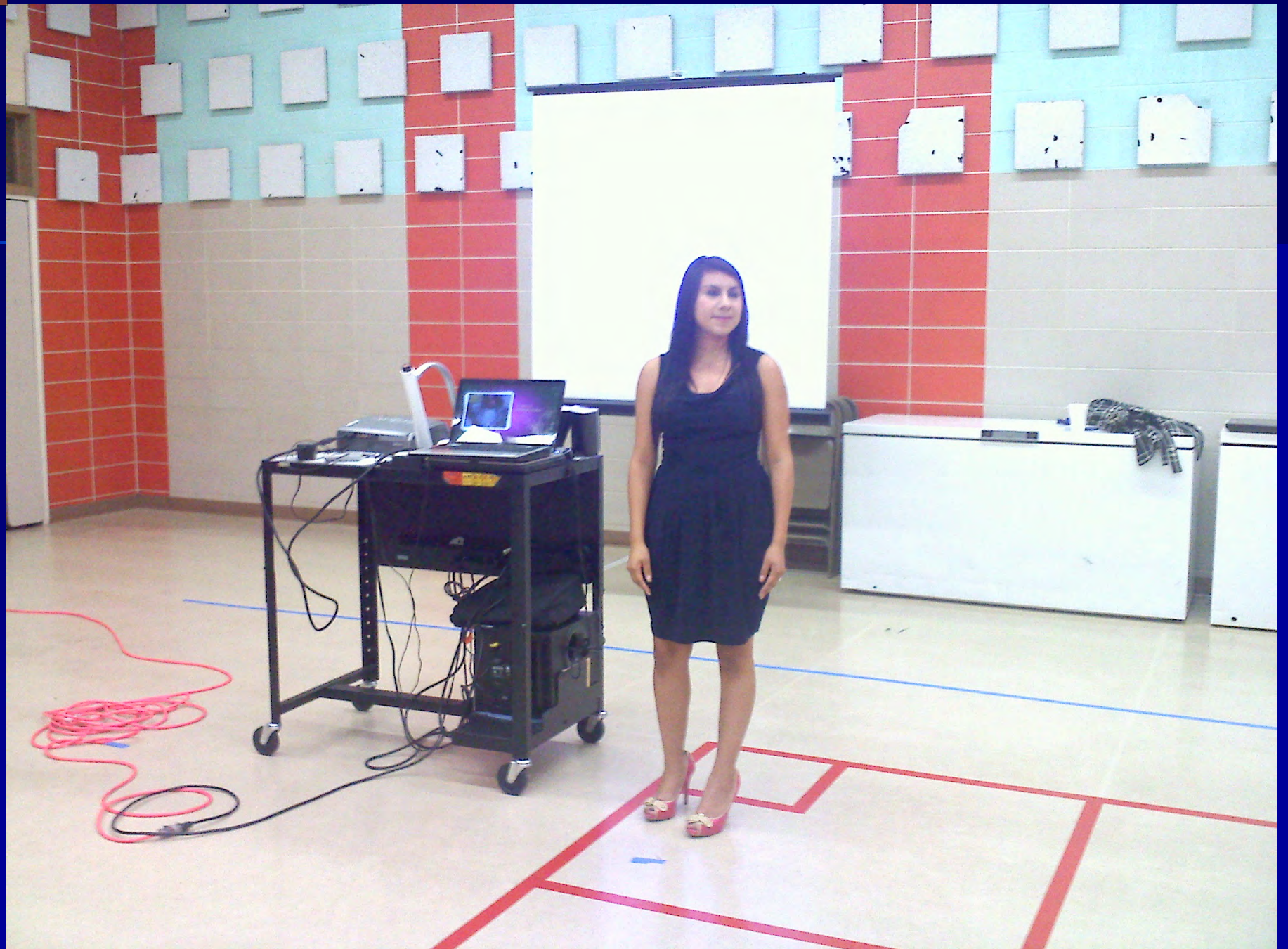

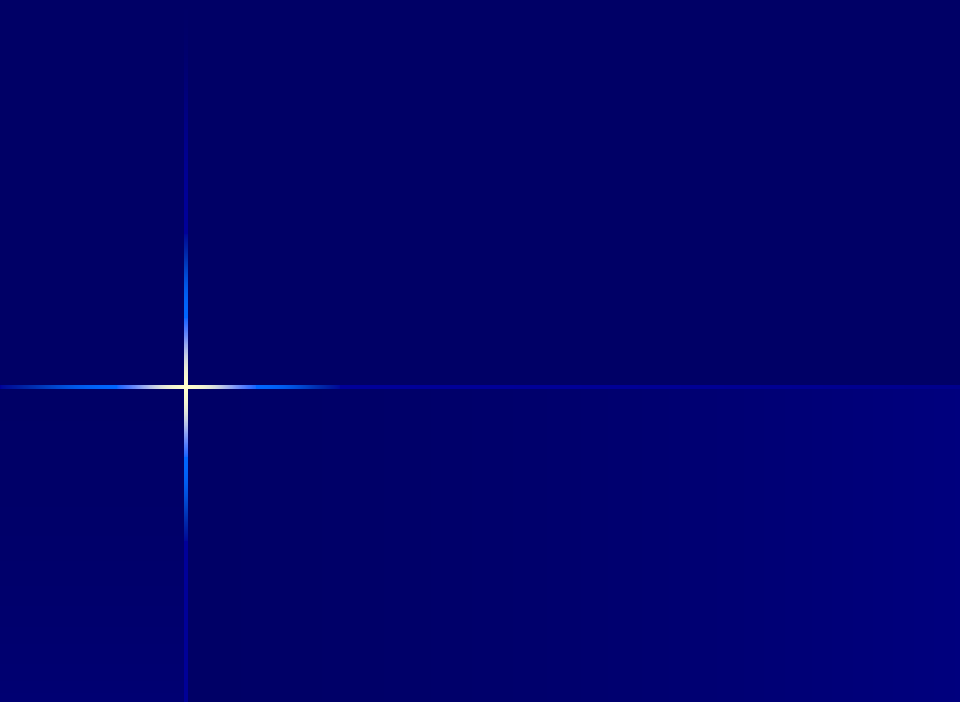
