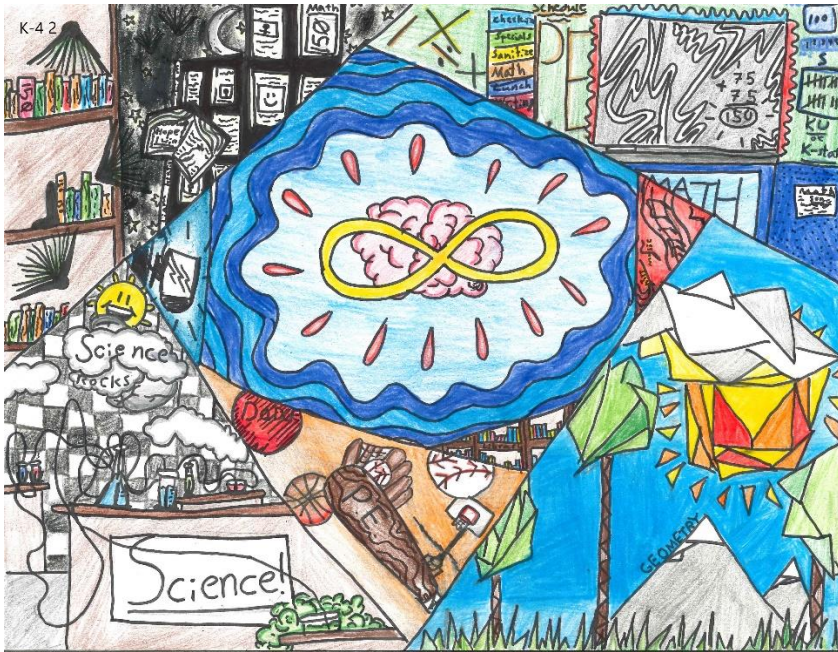


# 2021 STUDENT ART CONTEST WINNERS

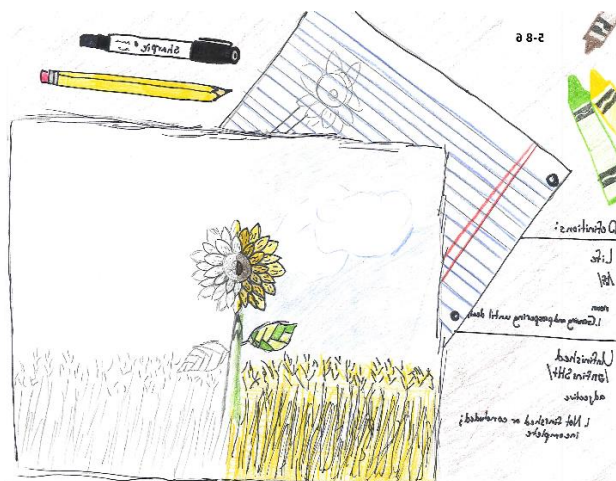
