What is the **ECHSA**?

- The Early College Health Sciences Academy offers an exceptional opportunity for students to integrate the last two years of high school and the first two years of college.
- It is a low cost, high impact way to begin college career early.
- The purpose is to help students move into health/science careers earlier and better prepared for success.
- The program allows graduating students to complete an Associates degree or earn a significant portion of it by the time of their high school graduation.

A little history...

- An advisory group first discussed the ECHSA in 2009, 3 years prior to SB 155.
- Program planning began, discussing
 - o Courses offerings
 - Wanted this to be a Program, not just college classes
 - o HS required for Graduation vs. Pre-Nursing course requirements
- Admission into program
 - o Complete Sophomore introductory course feeder and to spark interest
 - o Application
 - o GPA
 - o Teacher recommendation
 - o College entrance exam
- Incentive for students Nursing "Front of the Line"
 - o Dual credit
 - o Scholarships
 - o Textbooks
 - Community College Tuition
 - o CNA offered early so students could have a related employment
 - o Nursing "Front of the Line"

A little more history...

Site Preparation:

- Construction/Renovation began at BRH, 2010
 - o USD \$200,000 capital committed
 - o Architect cost
 - o HVAC, Electrical, Plumbing, resizing of rooms
 - o Butler
 - o Technology enhanced
 - $\circ~$ Room furniture and equipment
- Construction/Renovation began at BRH, 2011
 - o HVAC, Electrical, Plumbing
 - o Technology enhanced
 - o Rooms reconfigured
- Director hired, June 2011
 - Bridge between USD, parent, student and College
 - o These are HS kids
 - o Tours, camps, field trips keeps kids excited
 - o PR of program

A Few Highlights 💋



- The program has seen dramatic growth, from 11 students in 2011 to 77 in 2013
- An AM cohort was added to allow for expansion and schedule flexibility for students
- Spring Discovery Day was a huge success 77 students attended
- Partnerships with KU Area Health Center enrich the program, including
 - Camp Med
 - Journeys & Destinations
 - Doc for a Day
 - Women in Health Care Careers
- The ECHSA was recognized at the Capital as a CTE Showcase program for 2013
- SB 155 provides tuition for career path specific courses, certification incentive reimbursements to school districts, and transportation assistance

- One senior graduated from Butler the day before she graduated from her high school
- Many students are employed in health-related jobs, while in the program
- All graduating seniors have continued their education at the college level
- All juniors participate in job shadowing programs at area health-care providers
- 20K in grant funding was awarded from the Delta Dental of Kansas Foundation to provide scholarships and the implementation of the Intro to Oral Health Care class
- ECHSA students presented to area elementary students about a wide variety of health related topics. The presentations were well received and enjoyed by those participating. Feedback from the elementary school was very good.
- An active Advisory Council meets throughout the year
- Other institutions and school districts from outside our service area continue visit to our program for ideas and inspiration as they explore the Early College concept.



Career Pathways

- Continue at Butler in variety of programs: Nursing, Pre-Med, EMT, Pre-Vet, Fire Science, Science
 Education, Medical office support, etc.
- Transfer forward into 4 year university for further studies.
- Career into various health care positions.





- Tuition cost for Butler classes are at the current Butler rate, plus lab fees.
- Non-consumable textbooks for the Academy classes are paid for by the USD 394, and are checked out to students.
- Placement testing \$15 per setting.

Approx. Overall Costs:

53 credit hours 26 paid with CTE/Grants Total approx. tuition cost \$5035.00 <u>-2470.00</u> \$2565.00 = \$48/hour Here's how students BEGIN!!!
