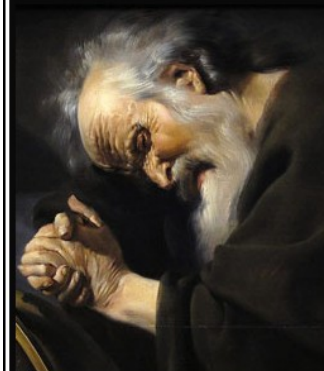

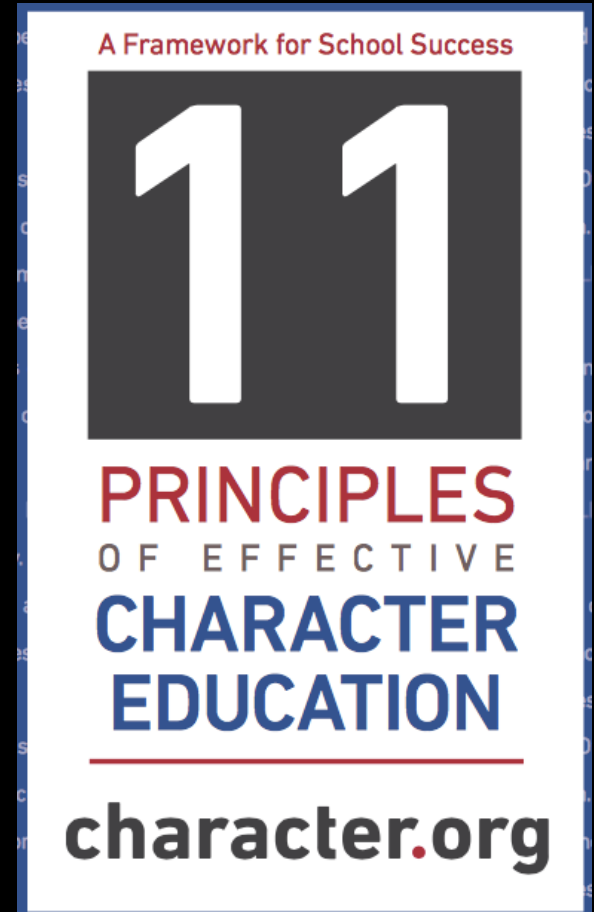


Good character is not formed in a week or a month. It is created little by little, day by day. Protracted and patient effort is needed to develop good character.

Why Core Values?

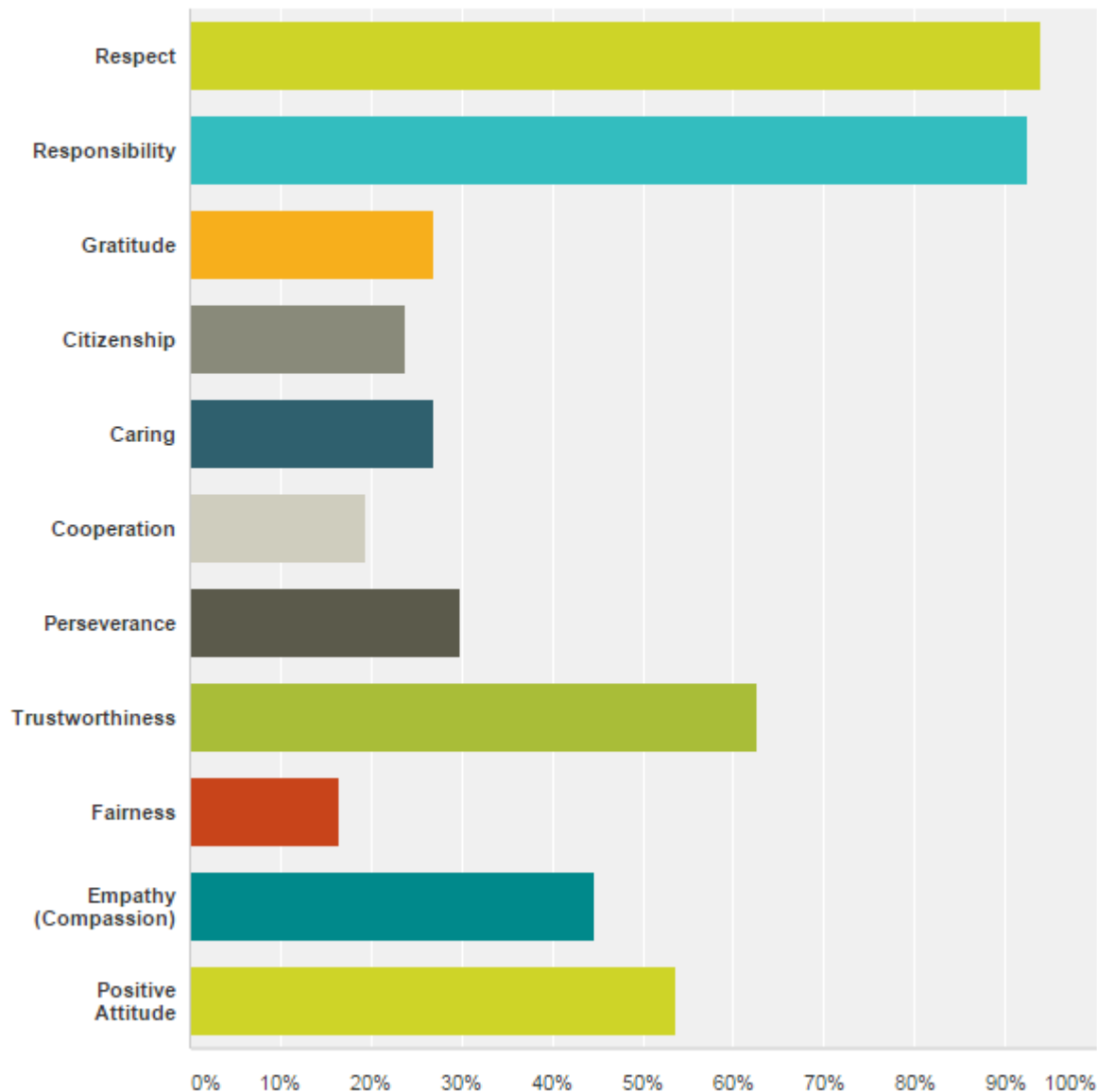
- Think of your favorite song....

 - Each homeroom submitted their top 4
- Staff reviewed and chose the most important core values during a staff meeting
- Surveyed parents to see what they valued
- Came up with a motto that was easy to remember

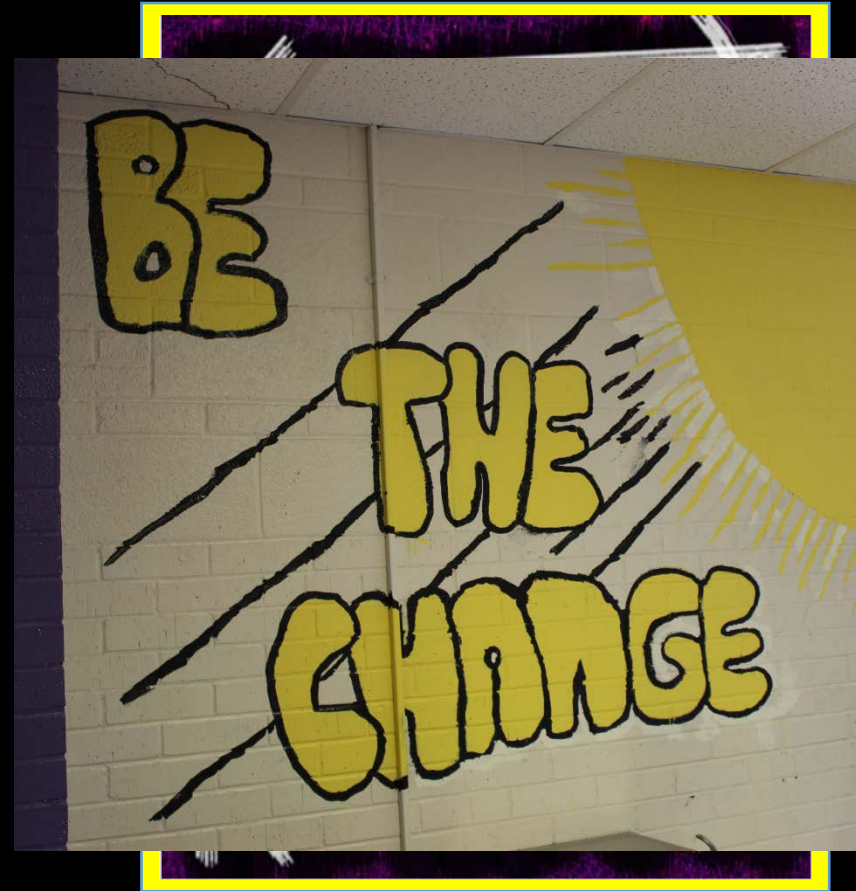


Implementing the 11 Principles of Character Education

Promotes core ethical and performance values

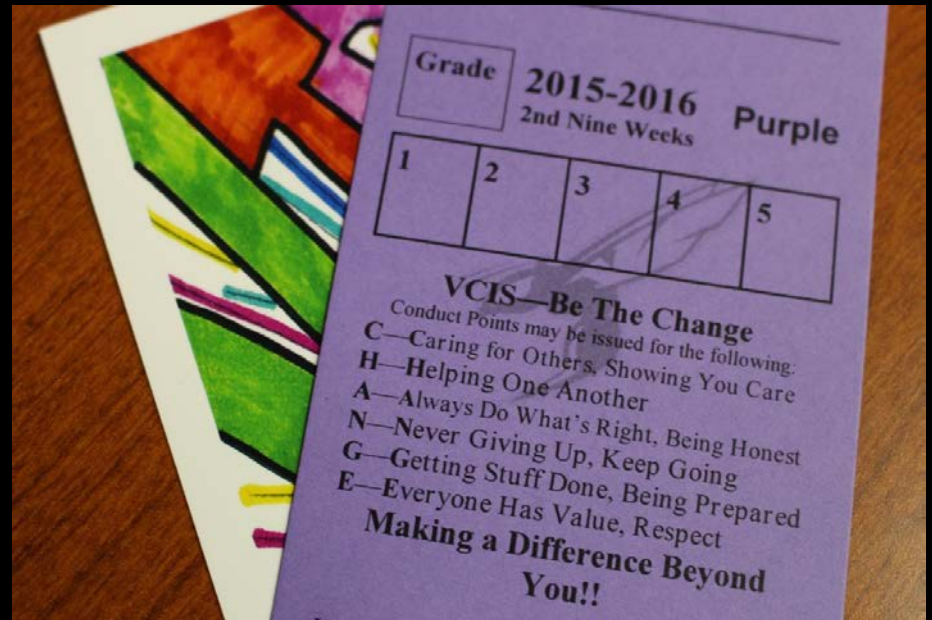
- Student, staff, parent & community input, District Task Force

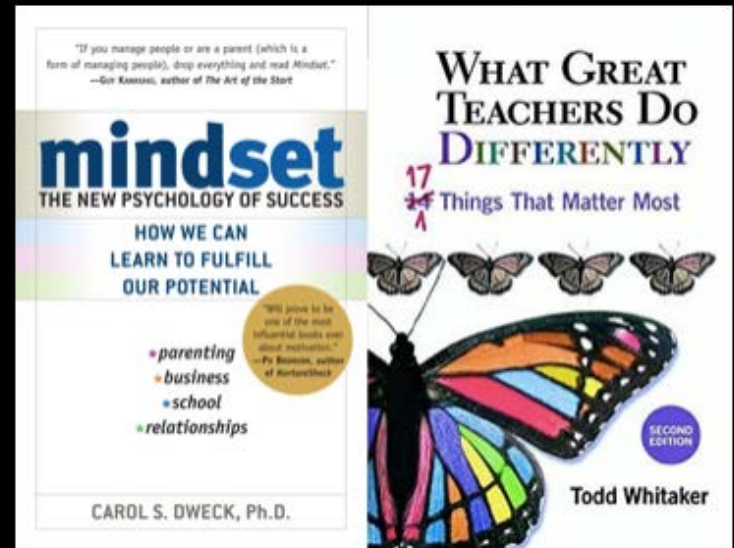

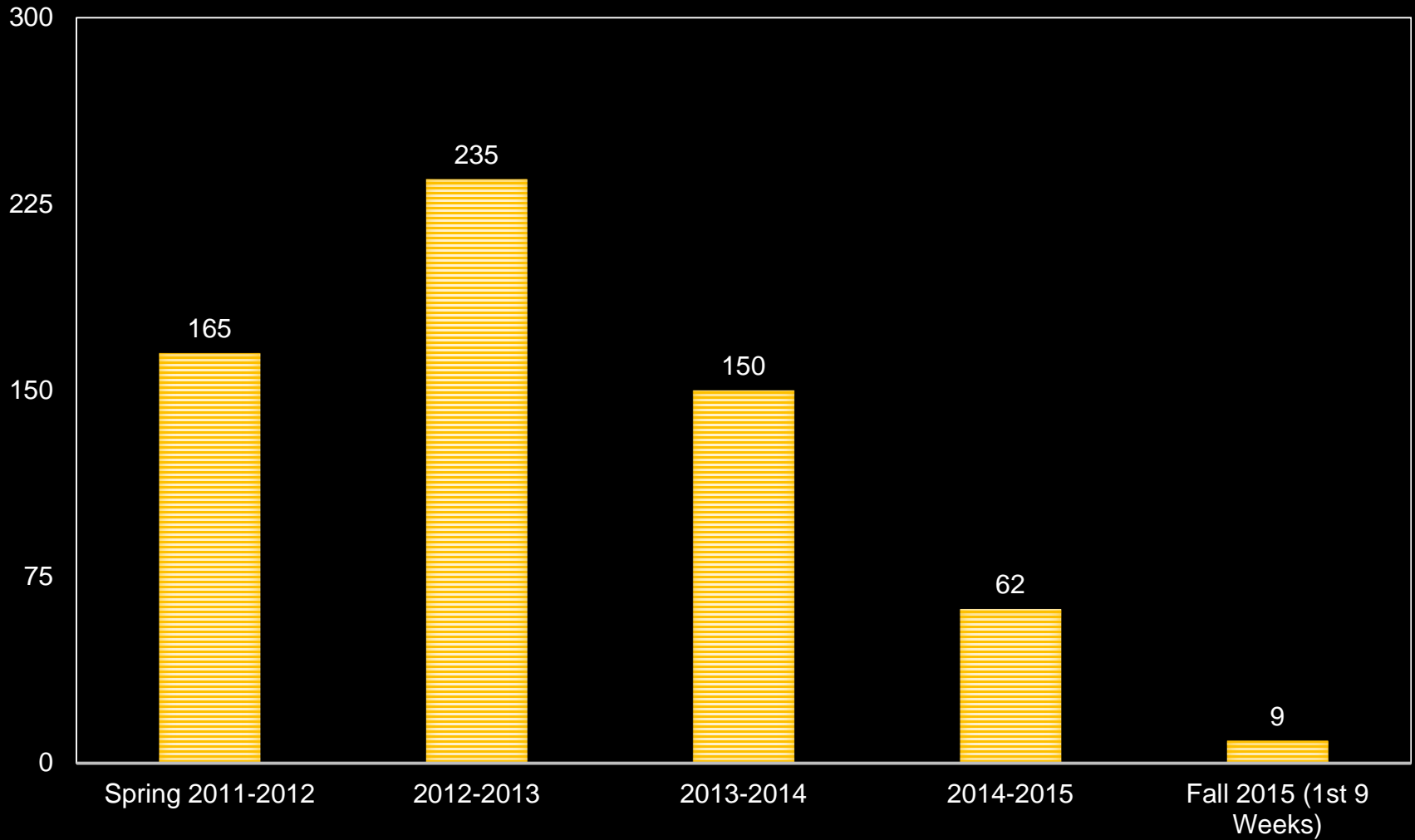

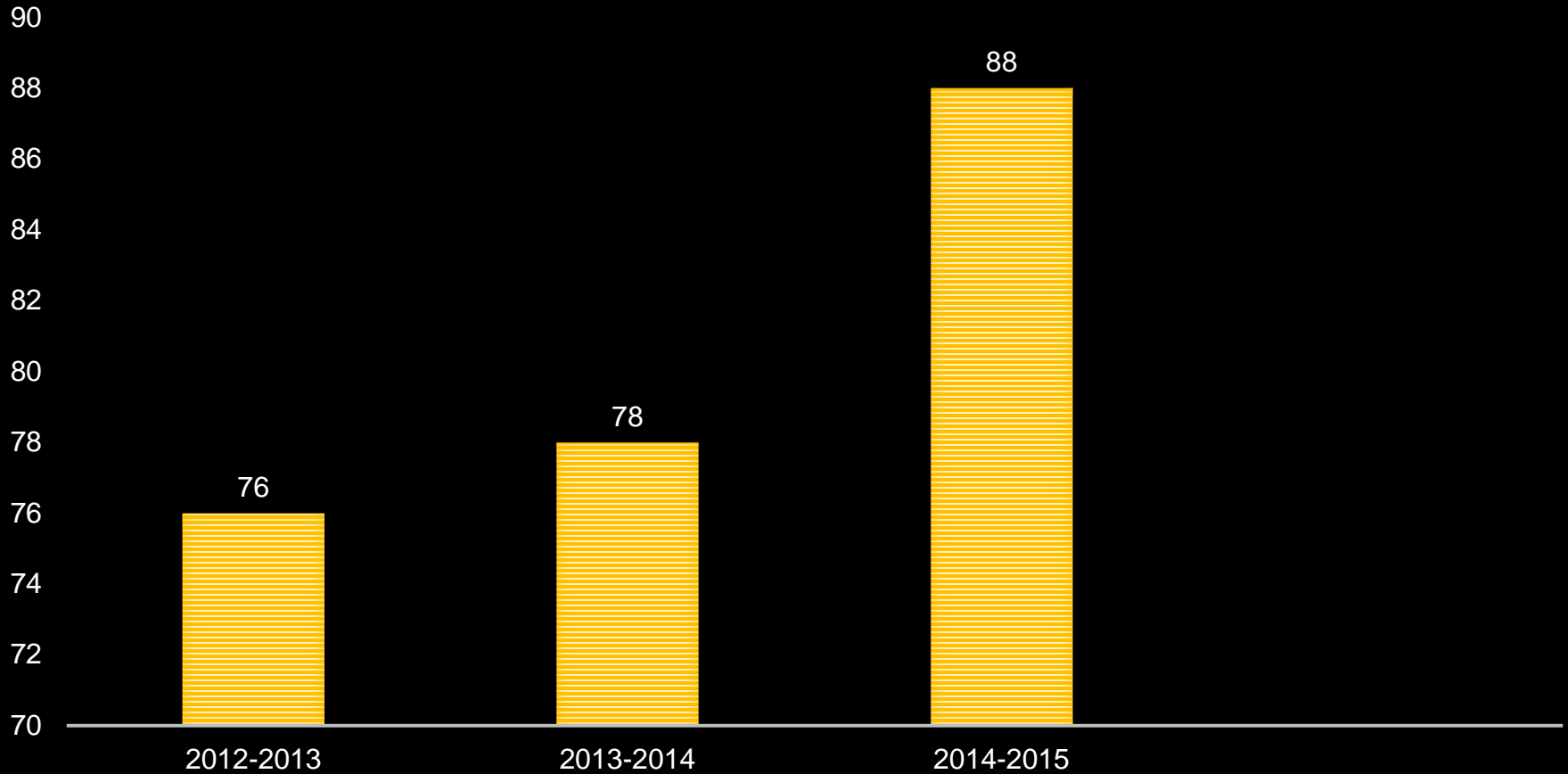
■ Number of Detentions
